She has also appeared in Amanda Maddock's puppet play "Mrs. Wright's Escape" and co-created the "Three Piggy Opera" at Links Hall in Chicago (with Barbara Whitney and Merrill Garbus). Most recently she collaborated with Philadelphia artist and filmmaker Naima Lowe on a performance/installation at Judson Church in NYC entitled "Mary and Sarah and You and Me". She is currently living and working in Montague, MA, where she performs, teaches, and supports children's theater, puppetry and music of all kinds.
